

- Dr. Frankenstein wants to fight the monster
- Goes up to the mountain which is where they meet
- Monster tells story of how he learns the language and culture of humans
- He tells Victor that he won't hurt him until he's heard his entire story

**Monster's Story (pg 105 and on for reference)**

- Finds a hut (a man inside is scared)
- Has Victor's notes (of the monster creation)
- Discovers natural sciences and moon (fire associates with warmth and light)
- He learns about hunger and how he needs to eat
- He teaches himself most anything
  - Language
  - History
  - Feelings and Emotions

He believes the language will aid his ability to interact with humans

- He sees his reflection in a pool, realizes he's a monster (pg 114)
- He learns to read (Chapter 15)
- References to Adam and he was created beautiful, the monster's creator knew he was "messed up"
- He's an 'invisible hand' for the family
- Finally talks to the blind man, torn away from family when they return- devastates monster

At this point the monster confesses to the murder of Justine and wants Victor to make him a female companion to render his unhappiness. Victor agrees to make the female monster, but sways in and out in the following chapters about whether to complete the 'project',

**~The issue of whether or not the monster would be happy if Victor taught him and loved him**

**~Who is more HUMANE?**

**~What were Victor's responsibilities when he first started?**
