Main Characters:

Gina-female who has an affair with Adrian Adrian- expert/novelist on Pancho Villa Ishmael-younger lover of Gina

Pancho Villa and masculinity

- -coffee story comes from Mexican history
- -illustrates dominant overpowering role of man in Mexican history

Connection of video to module

- -Pancho Villa mythical figure
 - -role in *Underdogs* general in the north, Demetrio starts fighting on his side

Pancho Villa real/role?

- -illustrates difference between traditional society and modern
- -is shot/stabbed when Adrian shows any behavior other than hyper-masculine
- -Role of his mother
 - -only female figure in which PV is subject to
 - -represents tradition

Portrayal of women

Parallels to the woman grinding corn artpiece

- -women not active in politics/ religion/ society
- -Gina portrayed solely as sexual object
- -even in workplace, women shown only to gossip—not hard workers
- -woman's role in kitchen-Adrian uses salt instead of sugar

Evolution of Adrian's perspective of women—does his view change?

- -starts out with many relationships, unable to settle down, multiple children with whom he has no sense relationship
- -then, after rejection by Gina, his view seems to change
 - -he spends time with his daughters
 - -pays child support in advance

How Gina changes

-she eventually decides to leave Adrian
