For each of the sentences below, take each of the following initial steps in analysis:

- Restate the sentence by expanding on a quantifier phrase. That is, make the quantifier phrase the subject followed by **is such that**, using a pronoun to fill the blank where the quantifier phrase was originally. (If your restatement sounds odd, you may not have identified the full quantifier phrase.)
- Mark the class indicator of the quantifier phrase.
- Describe the sort of thing that would count as a counterexample to the generalization.
- Classify the generalization as affirmative or negative and as direct or complementary.
  - (i) **Al located every part of the machine and labeled it.**
  - (ii) **Bill saw only large pieces that glistened in the sun.**
